2007 INTERNATIONAL SKIDCAR USERS CONFERENCE

LAS VEGAS, Nev., Jan. 22 – SkidCar System, Inc. today announced the 2007 International SkidCar Conference, presented by SkidCar System, Inc. and Cedergren's Mek Verkstad AB of Sweden.

A SkidCar is an ordinary vehicle that has been modified with a set of "training wheels" that are controlled from inside the car. The SkidCar uses hydraulics to lift the car just enough to limit normal traction and simulate driving on wet pavement, snow, ice, or dry pavement. Using a SkidCar, instructors teach a thought-based program of skid and accident avoidance in any weather without the use of lubricants or specialized driving surfaces.

SkidCar is based on the idea that it is the driver who controls the vehicle and that the driver's ability to make sound judgments can minimize risk and maximize control in any environment. Better yet, a driver trained on a SkidCar can learn to proactively avoid many high-risk situations altogether.

The conference will bring the SkidCar manufacturer and distributors from around the world together with public and private sector instructors and professional drivers to discuss strategies and potential improvements to the SkidCar and its uses.

"We're bringing SkidCar users together to hear how it is being used in many different locations, but more importantly to discuss our future," said SkidCar System President Dane Pitarresi.

The conference will include presentations from U.S. and European law enforcement agencies regarding their use and success with driver training programs. "The largest number of professional driving instructors are in law enforcement, so it just makes sense to introduce the municipal and private sectors to each other and see where this can go," Pitarresi said.

In addition to law enforcement trainers, the conference includes presentations by a large private U.S. driver training company, a municipal insurance corporation and a representative of Swedish Road Safety. The conference will conclude with a round table discussion on the future of driver education using the SkidCar.

SkidCar users from the United States, Canada, Sweden, UK, Japan, France, and Israel have already registered for the conference. The conference will be held April 9-11, 2007, at The Orleans Hotel & Casino, Las Vegas, Nev.
